Certification of Digital Accessibility Testing for the Website "Bercovici Fluidic Technologies Lab"

I hereby confirm that the website at the address: <https://www.fluidic.technology/> has been tested multiple times by Migdal Or – Ya'adim LeTzafon Association, founded by Rashi Foundation, starting from January 2024 up to (and including) July 2024. The testing process included generating a report of accessibility issues, implementing accessibility measures as feasible, and conducting follow-up tests after corrections were made.

It should be noted that the website is hosted on the WIX platform, and several components were found to be insufficiently accessible. These will be made accessible according to WIX's schedule. The site owner is aware that two external elements are integrated: LinkedIn & publications, which have partial accessibility.

Key Points of Website Accessibility:

- All website actions are accessible via keyboard and screen reader.
- The language of the website is defined in the <html> tag.
- All images and visual elements have alternative text.
- Sufficient contrast between text and background has been chosen.
- The focus order and reading sequence are consistent and correct.
- There is alternative text for images, buttons, and links, ensuring auditory feedback for all visual content on the site.
- Information on the site is organized in a hierarchical and simple manner.

As of July 8, 2024, the website is accessible according to the Equal Rights for Persons with Disabilities Regulations (Service Accessibility Adjustments) 2013 (hereinafter: "the regulations") and Standard 5568, which adopts the international WCAG 2.0 standard at level AA.

The findings mentioned are accurate as of the completion date of the site examination – July 8, 2024. If new elements are added or the content changes, additional issues may arise that were not present during the testing process. In any case, it is possible to contact the accessibility coordinator whose details are published in the site's accessibility statement as required by law.

It is clarified and emphasized that according to the Service Accessibility Regulations, the responsibility for maintaining the website's accessibility from the date of the above-mentioned test is on Bercovici Fluidic Technologies Lab.

Furthermore, it is clarified as follows: Migdal Or will not be liable for indirect and/or consequential damages (including loss of income or profit), and its liability for direct damages, if any, will only be in the following cumulative cases:

- In cases where Migdal Or was negligent according to the tests it could perform on the company's website according to the tools, knowledge, website technology, and existing regulations as of the agreement signing date, and not at a later date;
- The company's website was approved by Migdal Or without any changes and/or additions of any kind and type;

- Migdal Or's liability will in any case be limited to the amount paid to Migdal Or by the company for the services ordered under this agreement.
- After Migdal Or has been given a proper opportunity to defend itself against the claim and/or damage as applicable, and after a final judgment has been given.

The above does not impose any responsibility on Migdal Or to perform accessibility adjustments for new elements on the site that were not part of the original content and/or to require Migdal Or to make inaccessible parts of the site accessible.
